

POST 49 CONSTITUTION

ARTICLE V – OFFICERS

PROPOSED

Section 1. The officers of this Post shall be a Commander, a First and Second Vice- Commander, an Adjutant, a Finance Officer, **Assistant Finance Officer**, a Post Historian, a Post Chaplain, a Service Officer, a Judge Advocate Judge Advocate, a Sergeant-at-Arms, and such other officers as may be deemed necessary by the Post membership.

POST 49 BY-LAWS

ARTICLE II--- MANAGEMENT
